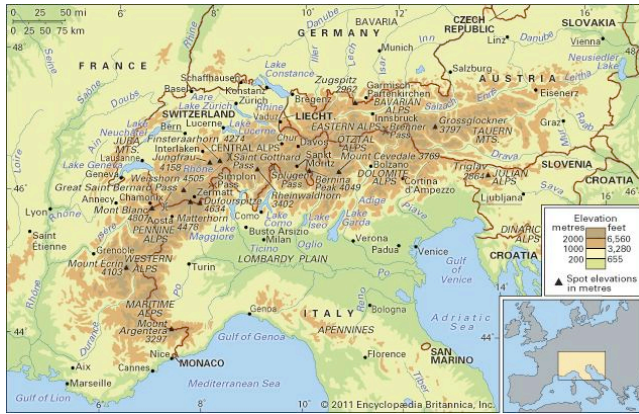
Political Map of Europe

Landmarks in Europe



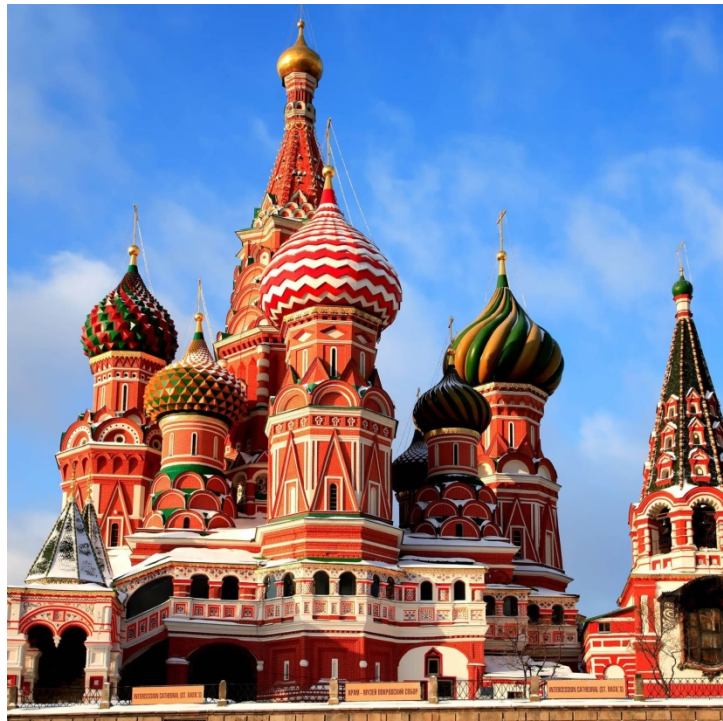
The Tower Bridge (London, England)

It is a bell tower of a cathedral. When this was built, the foundation on the ground was too soft on one side and it tilted.





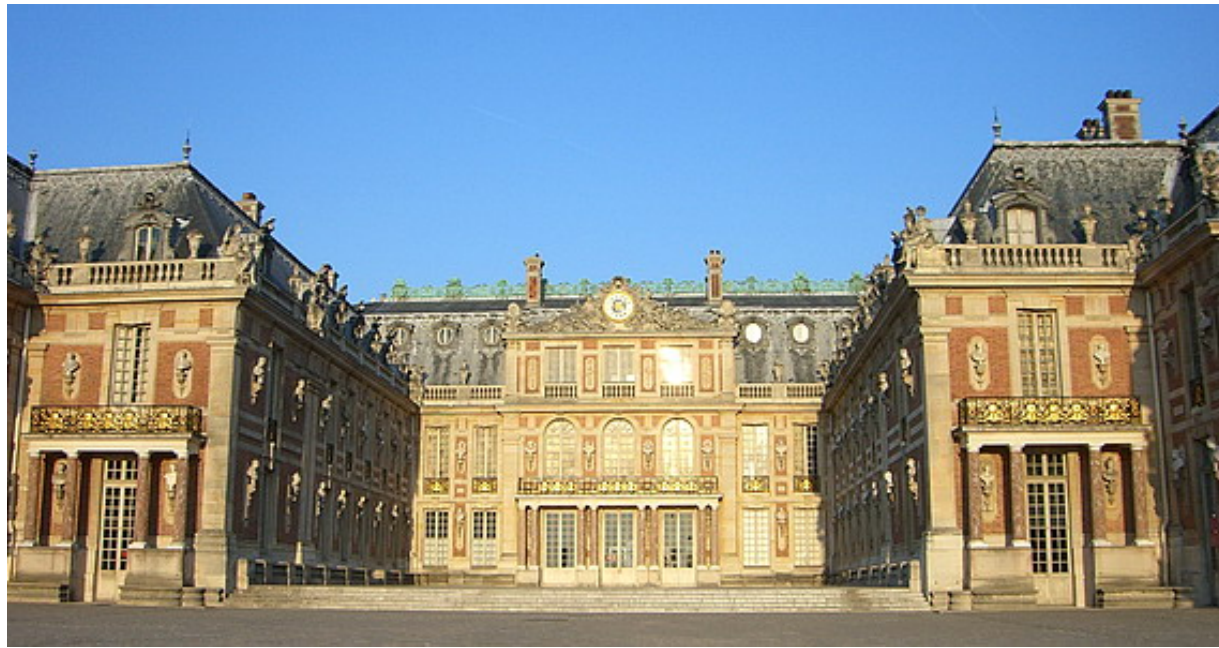
St. Basil's Cathedral (Moscow, Russia)

This used to be a church, now it is a museum. The building was built in shape as a flame of a bonfire rising from the sky.

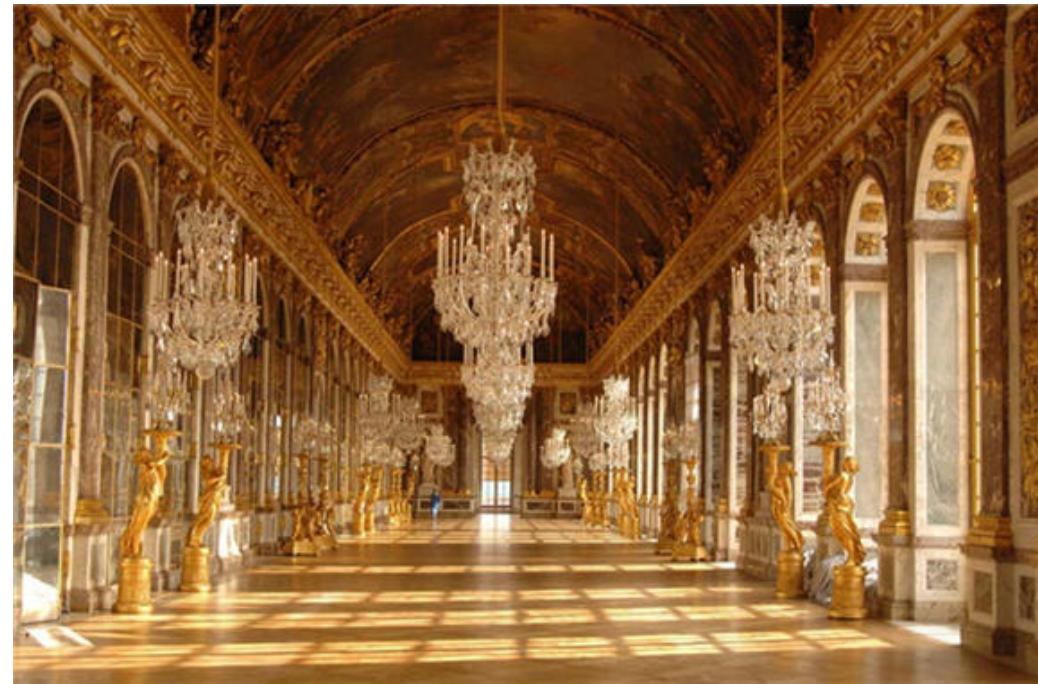
Notre Dame Cathedral

This royal palace is a popular tourist attraction.



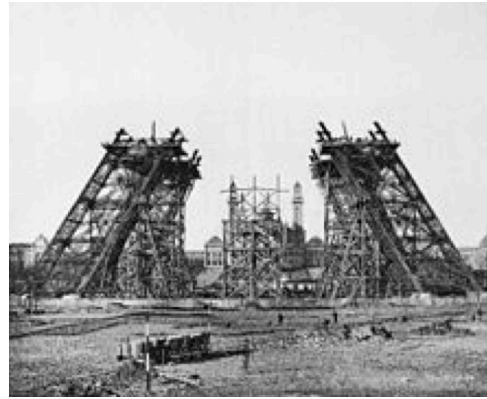


Colosseum (Italy)
